1. VOTED:

3. Human Services Update:
 - a. Hemali reported Michelle Kelleher was at a conference focused on Senior programming. Her topic Intergenerational Programs.
 - b. 217 Seniors participated in Town Flu/Covid booster clinics.
 - c. Theatre pharmacy is working with the Town to give boosters to homebound seniors and senior housing residents.
 - d. The Lexington Rotary working with Temple Isaiah and other volunteers to deliver Holiday Meals to Seniors. Last year they made 130 deliveries.

 - c. Within certain income caps Minuteman will pay relatives who take care of a disabled senior at home.
